Dear Pet Owner,

Thank you for reaching out to learn more about our services. Your beloved pet means the world to you and we take that bond very seriously. We are here to help safeguard that relationship by ensuring a mutual understanding and respect between you and your pet.

Our mission is to prevent behavior problems through education and to provide behavioral treatment to pets with existing behavior problems. We provide science based behavioral medicine to determine the motivation of behaviors and steps to help change underlying emotions that are driving those behaviors.

An initial appointment will require the following:

- 1) Complete a behavioral history form (additional attachment or link will be provided).
- 2) Ask your primary care veterinarian to provide medical records to us via email or fax, as we will be in close communications with them regarding your pet's wellness.
- 3) Upload a short video clip of the problem behavior provided no one is put in harms way to [managingmischiefandmore@gmail.com](mailto:managingmischiefandmore@gmail.com).

These forms must be completed and received at least 7 days in advance of your appointment. Please expect the initial appointment to last 2 hours at a cost of \$300\*. During the appointment, we will discuss your pet's primary behavioral concern, the

motivation for the behavior(s), and provide a treatment plan. Treatment plans will be reviewed in person and then written and emailed within 48 hours of your initial appointment. Treatment plans include safety recommendations, environmental changes, and behavior modification techniques; behavior medications may or may not be indicated depending on the pet and the problem. Pending time constraints and the tolerance of your pet, an in person behavior modification session may or may not be pursued during the initial appointment but will be discussed and reviewed during a recheck appointment. (\*\*\*) Please let us know if your pet has ever bitten a person or animal so that additional safety measures can be discussed beforehand (\*\*). An additional \$50 fee will be applied for any additional pet(s).

The initial appointment includes a 15-minute phone recheck at 2 weeks post-initial appointment and we encourage you to upload a secondary video clip if possible to review in preparation of this recheck. In many cases, regular in person rechecks are highly recommended starting at 1-2 months. Recheck appointments allow us to prescribe new or next level behavior modifications and make medication changes as needed. Recheck appointments are \$125 and scheduled for 60 minutes.

Lastly, we are excited to offer “Right Start” puppy and kitten appointments (for puppies and kittens less 6 months of age) to discuss common problems such as house training, play biting, or any other problem you might be experiencing. These are 1-hour appointments that cost \$150.

**\*\* Please note that at this time we are only able to offer in-home consultations.**
